1. You want photos of your fiancé getting ready (Tav stays with the bride).

2. You have a Jewish wedding - sometimes angles under the chuppah can be tough with all your family members under there. One photographer running from side to side is super distracting for your guests. Having 2 covers all angles.

3. You have over 75 guests and you want as much guest coverage as possible. I still can't guarantee 100% guest coverage with 2 photographers, but it's way closer than just one photographer. Under 75 guests, I can handle that solo.
